This Camp is on a first come, first served basis.

NOTE:

There will be NO paperwork or fees accepted at Check-In. All paperwork and fees must be received by the Rodeo Bible Camp Office on or before July 13, 2007 to be registered for camp.

Check In Time: 2:00pm to 4:00pm on July 30th

If you will be later than that (example: coming from another event) you must call us prior to check-in to get special permission to check-in later. We do understand unforeseen problems (flat tires, traffic, etc.) please try to call. Camp starts immediately after check-in.

Fees:

\$15.00 return check charge for each returned check.

\$20.00 of your registration fee is non-refundable.

If you withdraw your application:

Before July 6th you can receive your fees less \$20.00 back.

Between July 6th and July 29th only one half of your fees can be returned.

After July 29th no fees will be returned

*Final rulings on all refunds are made by the Camp Director.

Lodging:

Bunkhouses are provided with pre-assigned bunks. Campers are assigned counselors and bunks by camp policy. We cannot guarantee any campers will be placed together.

Please call **prior** to check-in with any questions.

Campers will be provided with three meals plus an evening snack daily.

Stalls:

A pre-assigned stall(s) will be provided for your horse(s). Sawdust will be provided.

Please bring all other items you need to care for your horse and clean your stall.

All tack/feed must be kept in assigned, secured areas.

Campers are not allowed to return to horse trailers or vehicles after camp begins.

Camper Rules:

Camp is designed to be fun and a great learning experience, for this to work we must ask you to follow these rules.

1. Campers are not allowed to leave camp grounds after being checked in.
2. Campers are required to attend all scheduled activities.
3. Camp is over after the awards ceremony following the rodeo.
4. No electronic devices are allowed (cd players, ipods etc...)
5. Cell phone use only by permission (this is strongly enforced)
6. No visitors are allowed except on rodeo day.
7. NO pets allowed!!
8. Absolutely NO Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco or Chew allowed.
9. No Stallions/Stud horses are allowed at camp.
10. No food or drink may be brought to camp without office staff permission.
11. Any inappropriate behavior as determined by camp leadership will result in the immediate expulsion from camp with no refund of monies or fees paid.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

*Note: We are not responsible for lost or stolen items

1. Bible (if you do not have one we will provide it)
2. Personal Care Items (soap, towel etc...)
3. Horse Gear and Necessary Tack (buckets, wheel barrow, pick, feed etc...)
4. Rodeo Gear (if any)
5. Clean Clothes-Western Attire (long sleeve shirts, boots and jeans) are required for the Rodeo. Western Attire is also required for some clinics when it involves safety (Rough Stock, Chute Doggin Etc...) otherwise modest attire is expected.
6. Clearly mark all your belonging with your name.
7. Sleeping Bag (boys may want to bring single size mats, girls will sleep on cots provided by camp)
8. Snack Money (there is a camp store)
9. Flashlight

Directions to the Oregon Horse Center:

I-5 to Eugene, Beltline Exit 195b. Head west towards Junction City/Airport. Travel Approximately six miles West on Beltline to N.W. Expressway Exit 7b. Turn right at the stop sign. Travel 2 miles (heading North on N.W Expressway to 90751. The Oregon Horse Center is on the right hand side of the road.

If coming from HWY 99, turn East on Awbrey Lane(adjacent to the Eugene Airport). Go approximately 1 mile to the end of Awbrey Lane. The Oregon Horse Center will be visible ahead and to your right.

RULES AND SCORING INFORMATION

Campers may choose three (3) events to practice,
but they will only be allowed to rodeo in two (2) of those events.

Scoring (by a point system) to determine winner of rodeo awards will be as follows:

30 points/day/memorization of Bible Verse (max. 90 points)

30 points-- 1st place (Rodeo Event)

20 points-- 2nd Place (Rodeo Event)

10 points-- 3rd place (Rodeo Event)

In the event of a tie, memorization of Bible Verses will take precedence in judge's ruling.

Camp Administration decisions are final.

We have fully read, understand and agree to the rules, terms and scoring information.
