Fees:

Camp Cost: \$190.00 (includes camper meals, lodging, stall and sawdust for 1 horse)
\$60.00 for each additional horse

Payment Options: (1) PayPal on the website (2) send check or money order (3) we can now take credit/debit cards over the phone prior to camp only. Call the office for details.

\$15.00 return check charge for each returned check.

\$20.00 of your registration fee is non-refundable.

If you withdraw your application:

Before June 27th your refund can be your fees less \$20.00.

Between June 27th and July 10th only one half of your fees can be refunded.

After July 10th no fees will be refunded.

*Final rulings on all refunds are made by the Camp Director.

Lodging:

Bunkhouses are provided with pre-assigned bunks. Campers are assigned counselors and bunks according to camp policy. We will not guarantee any campers will be placed together.

Please call prior to check-in with any questions.

Campers will be provided with three meals a day.

Stalls:

A pre-assigned stall(s) will be provided for your horse(s). Sawdust will be provided.

Please bring all other items you need to care for your horse and clean your stall.

All tack/feed must be kept in assigned, secured areas.

Campers are not allowed to return to horse trailers or vehicles after camp begins.

Please note some of the stalls are permanent and some are portable panels. The permanent stalls will be assigned first and then the portable stalls.

Camper Rules:

Camp is designed to be fun and a great learning experience. In order for this to work we must ask you to follow these rules.

1. Campers are not allowed to leave camp grounds after being checked in.
2. Campers are required to attend all scheduled activities.
3. Camp is over after the awards ceremony following the rodeo.
4. No electronic devices are allowed (cd players, ipods, etc...)
5. No visitors are allowed except on rodeo day.
6. No pets allowed.
7. Absolutely NO Drugs, Alcohol, Tobacco or Chew allowed.
8. No Stallions/Stud horses.
9. No food, drink or coolers may be brought to camp.
10. No tank tops of any kind are allowed.
11. Any inappropriate behavior as determined by camp leadership will result in the immediate expulsion from camp with no refund of monies or fees paid.
12. Cell Phones are not allowed at camp for any reason. Any camper found in possession of a cell phone may be immediately expelled from camp with no refund of monies or fees paid.

What To Bring To Camp:

*Note: We are not responsible for lost or stolen items

1. Bible (if you do not have one we will provide it).
2. Personal Care Items (soap, towel etc...).
3. Horse Gear and Necessary Tack (buckets, wheel barrow, pick, feed etc...).
4. Rodeo Gear (if any).
5. Clean Clothes-Western Attire (long sleeve shirts, boots and jeans) are required for the Rodeo. Western Attire is also required for some clinics when it involves safety (Rough Stock, Chute Doggin Etc...) otherwise modest attire is expected.
6. Clearly mark all of your belongings with your name.
7. Sleeping Bag.
8. Snack Money (there is a camp store).
9. Flashlight.

RULES AND SCORING INFORMATION

Scoring (by a point system) to determine winner of rodeo awards will be as follows:

- 30 points/day/memorization of Bible Verse (max. 90 points)
- 30 points--1st place (Rodeo Event)
- 20 points--2nd Place (Rodeo Event)
- 10 points--3rd place (Rodeo Event)

In the event of a tie, memorization of Bible Verses will take precedence in judge's ruling.
Camp Administration decisions are final.
